Beloved Parishioners of Holy Trinity,

It is with great joy that I announce the launch of our new initiative, “**2X2.**” This special campaign has one clear goal: to free our beloved parish from its mortgage within the next two years. The plan is simple yet powerful—each steward is invited to take their current annual stewardship pledge and double it (“2X”) for the next two years, with one portion continuing to support our regular stewardship needs and the other dedicated entirely to eliminating the mortgage.

In the weeks ahead, we will share more details about this program, along with the practical steps and spiritual vision that guide it. For now, I wish to offer a few theological and spiritual reflections on why being free from a mortgage is not only financially wise but also deeply beneficial for the mission and life of our Church.

Theological and Spiritual Reasons

Usury and Interest: The Orthodox Church has a long-standing tradition of condemning usury, which is the lending of money at interest. This view is rooted in both the Old and New Testaments. While modern economies are built on lending with interest, and the application of this teaching in the contemporary world is complex, the fundamental principle remains. A mortgage is a form of debt with interest, and therefore, an Orthodox church taking on such a loan could be seen as being in conflict with this teaching.

Trust in God's Providence: A church building is seen as God's house. By taking on a mortgage, a parish might be seen as relying more on a financial institution and its own ability to repay the debt rather than on God's provision. A church that is built or acquired through donations and without a mortgage demonstrates a greater degree of faith in God's ability to provide for His people and their spiritual needs.

Freedom from "Slavery": The Bible, particularly Proverbs 22:7, states that "the borrower is servant to the lender." A church with a mortgage is financially beholden to the bank or lending institution. This can limit the church's freedom to use its resources for ministry, charity, and other spiritual purposes, as a significant portion of its income would be dedicated to debt repayment. Being debt-free allows the church to be more flexible and responsive to the needs of its community and the wider world.

Avoiding Worldly Concerns: Focusing on fundraising for a mortgage can shift the church's focus away from its primary mission of worship, evangelism, and spiritual life. Being free from the burden of debt allows the community to concentrate on its spiritual growth and service, rather than on financial obligations.

Practical and Communal Benefits

Financial Stability: A church without a mortgage is in a much stronger and more stable financial position. It is not vulnerable to economic downturns, interest rate fluctuations, or the risk of foreclosure. This stability allows the church to better weather financial crises and ensures the continuity of its ministry.

Direct Use of Funds: Without a mortgage payment, the money collected from parishioners can be directly used for ministry, charitable works, parish operations, and supporting clergy. This allows the church to have a greater impact on its community and to fulfill its mission more effectively.

Stewardship: A debt-free church models good stewardship for its members. It encourages the congregation to give generously and to trust in God's provision, reinforcing the idea that the church's resources are a gift from God to be used for His glory, not for worldly obligations.

Community Building: The process of building or acquiring a church without a mortgage often requires a concerted effort from the entire community through donations and volunteer work. This collaborative effort can strengthen the bonds of the parish and foster a deeper sense of ownership and commitment among the members.

I know in my heart that our faithful and growing community would have no problem in eliminating our mortgage much faster than 2 years. Please Pray and Commit to this blessed endeavor!
